There is an initiative currently under review Nationally surrounding the Code of Conduct. The SLCC will be contributing information from regional feedback in support of bringing in proper legislation to make the Code of Conduct more legally accountable. This work is currently being looked at to consider the lack of accountability that Councils have when problems arise with a public complaint to employment issues. Currently the Monitoring Office holds limited authority to act when Council members are reported for possible code of conduct breaches. This has put enormous strain on the industry and is thought to be costing Authorities disproportionately and lacking to serve the general public over-all.

The Council agreed in 2019 for the Clerk to begin the second part of certification (CiLCA). The Clerk will begin this course in September 2020.

There is still concerns expressed over the issue of speeding. Many residents walk their kids to school and at times need to be on the roadway. RT to make further inquiries into signage, speed restrictions for local bins. The SID (speed indicator devise) has been discouraged due to cost and effectiveness. RT is also going to contact Ogbourne St Andrew and consult on what the village has put in place to reduce the speeding issues there.

EM asked to check with highways regarding the planned road markings for the A346 and see when Wiltshire has this planned to be completed.
